Spring cleanup is right around the corner!

Spring cleanup, scheduled for **May 6th – May 10th** gives residents the opportunity to dispose of large, non-hazardous items that trash haulers do not normally pick up. It is also a great time to address overgrown yards and trees. Don't miss out on this opportunity! Your spring cleanup day will be scheduled for the same day as your normal trash pickup, and items should be placed in the same area as your regular trash by **7:00 AM**. - Chairs
- Couches
- Bed Frames

Appliances

- Washers/Dryers
- Ranges
- Dishwashers
- Microwave ovens
- Hot Water Heater

Kids Toys

- Bicycles
- Swing Sets
- Outdoor Toys/ Kid Pools

Garage Items

- Old Paint Cans (must be dry)
- Storage Boxes
- Christmas Trees
- Patio Furniture
- Empty Propane Tanks (must remove valves)

Yard Waste

- Leaves/Grass (Must be boxed or bagged)
- Tree Limbs (Must be cut and bundled- no longer than 6 ft)

Items NOT Accepted

Electronics

- TVs
- Computers
- Printers
- Tables/Cell Phones

Construction Materials

- Drywall
- Carpet
- Nails/ Screws
- Scrap Metal

Hazardous/Bio Hazardous Waste

- Corrosives
- Pesticides
- Herbicides
- Car Batteries
- Antifreeze
- Motor Oil
- Prescription Drugs
- Used Needles or Syringes
- Liquids of any kind

Items Accepted for Additional Charge

Refrigerators or freezers	\$5.00 each
Automobile tires up to 16"	\$4.00 each
Truck tires 17" to 24.5"	\$7.00 each
Tractor tire up to 18.4"	\$30.00 each
Implement tires (larger than 24.5")	\$37.50 each

City Code

Chapter 8.70 of the Wray Municipal Code restricts garbage, junk, litter, trash or abandoned vehicles on any property within the City limits. A landowner in violation of this chapter will be issued a notice. If the condition of the property is not corrected within twenty (20) days, the property will be cleaned by the city and the property owner becomes responsible for the cleanup costs.
