CALL TO ORDER

Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Robert Kraus called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call

City Clerk Emily Ellis conducted Roll Call. Council member Brad Rockwell was absent.

ADDITION TO AND ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Mayor Pro tem Chad Deyle made a motion to adopt the June 29, 2020 Special Council Meeting Agenda. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Council member Scott Weaver made a motion to approve the June 9, 2020 City Council Meeting Minutes. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

Resolution 21-2020: Memorandum of Understanding and Cooperative Agreement Related to Distribution of Cares Act Funds

City Manager James DePue explained that the MOU was between the City of Wray, City of Yuma, Town of Eckley, and Yuma County pertaining to the distribution of the federal CARES Act funds in the amount of \$859,500. The Council was advised that Yuma County had been allocated \$45,820.71, the City of Yuma had been allocated \$47,518.36, the City of Wray had been allocated \$60,218.43, and the Town of Eckley had been allocated \$3,050.50. The remaining \$702,892.00 had been allocated to local COVID-19 economic recovery grant programs to be fiscally managed by Yuma County and administered by a committee consisting of representation from each of the four entities. The Council was informed that the Colorado Department of Local Affairs would be administering the funds to Colorado counties and providing guidelines for the use of the funds. Mayor Pro tem Chad Deyle made a motion to approve Resolution 21-2020: Memorandum of Understanding and Cooperative Agreement Related to the Distribution of Cares Act Funds. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.


