CALL TO ORDER

Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Robert Kraus called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call

City Manager James DePue conducted Roll Call with all members present.

ADDITION TO AND ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Council member Greg Jones made a motion to adopt the November 10, 2020 Council Meeting Agenda. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Council member Scott Weaver made a motion to approve the October 13, 2020 Council Meeting Minutes. The motion was seconded and passed with six supporting votes. Council member Greg Jones abstained from the vote.

PRESENTATIONS

Ronnie Workman – Golf Carts on City Streets

Ronnie Workman asked the Council to consider legalizing the use of golf carts on streets within the City of Wray. Discussion followed regarding mandates and restrictions that would need to be included when drafting an ordinance. Council members agreed to consider the request and review other cities' existing ordinances relating to golf carts.

CIRSA-Equipment Breakdown Coverage

City Manager James DePue explained that the 2021 CIRSA Equipment Breakdown Coverage quote in the amount of \$2,252.00 reflected an increase of \$135.38 over the 2020 premium cost. Mayor Pro tem Chad Deyle made a motion to approve the 2021 Equipment Breakdown Coverage Plan quote from CIRSA. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Ordinance #621-1st Reading Adopting 2021 Budget

Council member Greg Jones made a motion to approve the first reading of Ordinance #621 Adopting the 2021 Budget for the City of Wray. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Mayor Pro tem Chad Deyle made a motion to approve a contribution to NECALG – County Express in the amount of \$4250.00. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.


