

2022 PICKUP, CLEAN-UP, & RECYCLE

The City of Wray has designated May 9th – 13th as
“Spring Clean-Up”

A Special Trash Pick Up Day Has Been Scheduled For Your Neighborhood.

This is your opportunity for spruce-up, paint-up, or clean-up of vacant lots, rental or personal residential property, or local commercial property.

Household and yard waste, furniture and appliances will be picked up. Tree limbs should be cut in lengths no longer than six feet and bundled. Leaves and grass clippings should be boxed or bagged. Propane bottles must have the valves removed. Place items out next to curb or alley at your regular trash location by 7:00 AM on the day listed.

We are unable to accept electronics.

If the following items are picked up at your address you will be charged as follows:

Refrigerators or freezers	\$ 5.00 each
Automobile tires up to 16”	\$ 4.00 each
Truck tires 17” to 24.5”	\$ 7.00 each
Tractor tire up to 18.4”	\$30.00 each
Implement tires (larger than 24.5”)	\$37.50 each
Other tires – call for price	
Mattresses or box springs	\$10.00 each

Monday, May 9 th	Hale Street to Lincoln Street, Jonesville to Peakerville
Tuesday, May 10 th	Dexter Street to Hale Street
Wednesday, May 11 th	Cedar Street to Dexter Street
Thursday, May 12 th	Ivy Lane to Cedar Street
Friday, May 13 th	South Ridge, Canyon Court, Golf Sub, and Industrial Park

After your neighborhood’s assigned day, any additional requests for refuse pickup must be scheduled by May 13th and will be completed as the Public Works & Utilities schedule permits. Additional charges will apply after this date.

ITEMS SHOULD BE PLACED IN THE SAME AREA AS YOUR REGULAR TRASH AND MUST HAVE OPEN ACCESS FOR SKID LOADERS AND TRUCKS.

The trash truck will pick up regular trash and large items will be picked up by another City crew.
