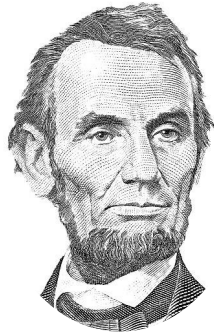




# 2022 Fall Film Series

Join us on the first & third Thursdays of the month at 11 am for our hour long "Brown Bag" discussion group. Bring your lunch to enjoy as we view docu-drama films from the Ryan Film Library produced by David L. Wolper in the 1970s about our 16th President, Abraham Lincoln.

*David L. Wolper was a award-winning television documentary producer best known for the blockbuster TV miniseries "Roots" and for the spectacular opening and closing ceremonies he created for the 1984 Olympic Games in Los Angeles. He produced no less than 700 films, garnering 150 awards including two Oscars, 50 Emmys, seven Golden Globes and the Jean Hersholt Humanitarian Award. He has also been inducted into the Television Hall of Fame, presented with the French National Legion of Honor, and is the recipient of the first IDA Mentor Achievement Award. In 1958, he founded Wolper Pictures, which produced both documentaries and television specials. With his documentaries, docu-dramas, biographies and nature-travel programs, he offered a sense of active involvement in the adventure, in the battle, and in the extravagant and sometimes decadent lives of the world's power players.*
