

## ***WRAY MUSEUM VISITOR POLICY***

In order to offer optimum access to the Museum facilities and exhibits, while at all times ensuring the safety and security of our visitors, staff and Collection; we ask visitors to the Museum adhere to the following rules:

- Oils from the human body cause considerable damage to artifacts - please do not touch
- Shoes and shirt are required at all times in the Museum
- Food, drinks, and gum are prohibited in all areas of the Museum. An exception is made for baby bottles containing water, milk or formula only, no juice. Sippy cups and juice boxes are not bottles and are not allowed.
- Covered containers of water are allowed in all areas of the Museum
- Strollers are permitted in the Museum
- Children under eight (8) years of age must be accompanied by an adult
- All areas of the Museum are wheelchair accessible. Motorized wheelchairs are permitted.
- Visitors are encouraged to leave any bags or packages in their vehicles that are not needed during their visit to the Museum. Extra large bags will need to be left near the office.
- Smoking and E-cigarettes are not allowed anywhere in the building or the front parking lot.
- Pets are not allowed except for service animals and the Museum is not responsible for pets left outside the building
- Please refrain from using loud, abusive, or otherwise improper language.
- Museum staff has the right to work in a safe environment free from violence, abuse or threatening behavior. The Museum reserves the right to remove any person acting in an unacceptable manner.
- The Museum premises are monitored by video surveillance.
- The Museum permits still and video photography for noncommercial use only in its museums and exhibitions, unless otherwise posted. Photographs and videos may not be reproduced, published, distributed, transferred, sold or otherwise commercially exploited without the express written permission. - Flash photography and tripods are not allowed on the premises.
